REGULATIONS OF THE SAMBO CHAMPIONSHIP

I European Senior Cup 2015 (M-F) 23 – 26 October, 2015, Polideportivo Municipal SAN AGUSTÍN DEL GUADALIX (MADRID) SPAIN

### 1. General Conditions

- 1.1. I European Senior Cup of Sambo will be carried out in accordance with the rules provided by the FIAS and the ESF (European Sambo Federations).
- 1.2. I European Senior Cup of Sambo is organized and held by the ESF and the Madrid Wrestling and Sambo Federation together with the Spanish Federation of Olympic Wrestling and Associated Disciplines.

## 2. Place and Dates

- 2.1. Place: Sports Complex "San Agustín del Guadalix (Madrid)" (www.fmlucha.es)
- 2.2. Dates: from the 23<sup>rd</sup> to 26<sup>th</sup> of October 2015
- 2.3. Place of competition and accreditation: Sports Complex "San Agustín del Guadalix"
- 2.4. Place of accommodation: To be confirmed by the Organization
- 2.5. Accreditation for the teams will be held in Organization Hotel

## 3. Athletes Participation

- 3.1. Every National SAMBO Federation can apply only one athlete in each weight category, the country hosting the competition has the right to present 2 athletes in each weight category.
- 3.2. Each athlete must have medical examination before leaving the home country for the Championship. Results have to be marked in the SAMBO license book. All members of the national delegations should present their medical insurance at the accreditation.
- 3.3 All athletes must have medical insurance, which will be checked at weigh-in. The athletes who do not have the compulsory health insurance will be provided with it by the Championship Organizing Committee with possibility to purchase the relevant insurance at their own cost when accrediting. Athletes without medical insurance are not allowed to participate in the championship.

# 4. Applications for Participation

4.1. The Federation maximum quota is 24 persons, according to the following official composition:

Athlete women – 9 / Athlete men – 9 / Head of delegation– 1 / Coach – 3 / Medical – 1 / Referee - 1

- 5. Technical Terms
- 5.1. Weight categories:

SAMBO (Male):

52Kq, 57kq, 62kq, 68kq, 74kq, 82kg, 90kg, 100Kg y + 100 Kg.

SAMBO (Female):

48 Kg, 52kg, 56kg, 60kg, 64kg, 68kg, 72kg, 80Kg +80Kg

- 5.2. Individual contests are held in groups according to the system of eliminations and repechages.
- 5.3. Athletes who won first three prize places will be awarded with medals and diploma.
- 5.4. Team places are given according to the points collected in the individual classification. Teams who won first three prize places will be awarded with cups.
- 5.5. All participants will take part in the official ceremonies.
- 5.6. All delegations must have a CD with the National anthem and two National flags (1x2m). During the ceremony, national anthems and rising of National flags ceremonies are performed simultaneously in the honor of the winners.
- 5.7. The Organizing Committee guarantees first aid provision to all members of sport delegations.

5.8 First entry form for participation as well as the visa application form to the competition should be sent to the Organizing Committee before September 2, 2015. Travel details of the delegation should be sent before October 5, 2015.

#### 6. Financial Terms and Rates

- 6.1. Each member of the delegations must pay the participation fee counting 75€ per person per day (2 meals a day plus accommodation)
- 6.2. The fee for the transfer Madrid Airport- Hotel -Sports complex and back is 20 € per person.

All national SAMBO Federations must pay in advance for accommodation meals and transfer of the delegations by October 10, 2015 via bank transfer to the account of the Madrid Federation of Olympic Wrestling and Associated Disciplines:

- 6.3. Managers of delegations have to fulfill all financial obligations with the Organizing Committee on the arriving day and carry out all accreditation demands.
- 6.4. All participants arriving at the competition and not included in the application form before the 2nd of September must pay 90€ per day for accommodation.
- 6.5. The Organizing Committee provides the EFS President, EFS Secretary General and 10 referees with meals and accommodation. The ESF provides salary for 10 referees for their work at the competition.

#### 7. Accreditation

- 7.1. All members of the National SAMBO Federation shall be accredited.
- 7.2. The accreditation will take place at the hotel, located at San Agustín del Guadalix CP 28750 Madrid (España)
