1. GENERAL TERMS

- 1.1 Youth and Junior Sambo World Championships 2021 (hereinafter referred to as the Sambo World Championships) shall be held in accordance with the FIAS Regulations on Preparation and Staging of the Official Competitions (sport and organizational rules) and the International sambo Competition Rules.
- 1.2 Sambo World Championships shall be held in order to decide on the winner in corresponding age groups as well as to promote and develop sambo worldwide, and strengthen the international relations.

2. COMPETITIONS ORGANIZERS

2.1 General management of the organization and holding of the Sambo World Championships 2021 shall be the responsibility of the International Sambo Federation (FIAS) together with Hellenic Sambo Federation.

3. DATES AND VENUE

4. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION

- 4.1 Those athletes who are affiliated to their National Sambo Federation at the age of 16-18 (2003-2005, Youth, M&F) and 18-20 years of age (2001-2003, Juniors M&F) are able to participate in the Championships.
- 4.2 To enter Greece and participate in the competitions, each team member must pass COVID-19 PCR test in their respective countries and have a negative result taken no earlier than 72 hours before arrival. The test results must be sent by e-mail to the Organizing Committee of the competitions, and a hard copy presented at the accreditation.
- 4.3 To enter Greece 24 hours before arrival every member of delegation must register on the website https://travel.gov.gr. Upon arrival to the Hellenic Republic all the members of delegation must pass COVID-19 PCR test in the airport of Thessaloniki or at the hotel. Price for the test is 35€person.
- 4.4 The World Sambo Championships among Youth and Juniors will be organized in accordance with the instructions and rules imposed by the Hellenic Republic based on COVID-19 safety measures and travel regulations. Measures and regulations are subject to change due to constant revision and assessment of the ongoing pandemic.
- 4.5. Registration of the teams to the competitions is made by means of FIAS online license and competitions registration system at http://registration.sambo.sport Each National Sambo Federation should get a login and a password from FIAS to access the system. Admission of the athletes to the competitions is made only by means of the system. The cost of license is **60 USD**, which includes **the international sports insurance** for the selected competitions from FIAS calendar. Athletes of 2005 year of birth in order to participate should have written permission of a doctor in English.

- 4.7 Hellenic Sambo Federation will provide visa support only for those delegations, which will apply through the FIAS Database.
- 4.8 According to the Organising and Holding of the Official FIAS Competitions Appendix 7 (page 24) each competitor is obliged to have a backnumber comprising his last name and his National Olympic Committee abbreviation on the back of his uniforms (red & blue). The backnumber should comply with the FIAS Specification sheet for SAMBO Backnumber manufacturing.
- 4.9 During the accreditation, all the countries delegates should provide the Organizing Committee with a short version (not more than 30 seconds) of corresponding national anthem in electronic format (soft copy) and two national flags 2x1m.

5. ANTIDOPING

- 5.1 Doping control will be conducted by the National Anti-Doping Organization officially recognized by WADA. The selection of the athletes will be carried out in accordance with the FIAS Anti-Doping Rules 2021 which are based on 2021 WADA Code. The selected athletes will be accompanied by a chaperone of the Organization since the moment when receive the notice until they arrive to the doping control station. A person of the choice of the athletes (the team physician, coach and head of delegation) can accompany them. In case of which the Organizing Committee does not provide accreditation card with photography the selected athlete is required to provide to the Doping Control Officer a valid passport or identity document with photo.
- 5.2 The teams' representatives must carefully plan their departure date and time after the competition taking into account that the athletes may be selected for the Doping Control.

6. ENTRIES

7. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

- 7.1 Each delegation member shall pay a fee at the amount of **100 USD or \\$5** per day to the Organizing Committee (accommodation and meals 2 times a day). Minimum accommodation duration is three days.
- 7.2 The cost of transfer from airport or railway station to the official hotel and back and during competitions from official hotel to the competition venue and back costs 20 USD or €17 for each team member and to be paid by the national federations.
- 7.3 In case of individual reservation of accommodation each national federation shall pay an accreditation fee at the amount 150 USD for each team member (accommodation, meals, transfer are not included in this fee) to the Organizing Committee to cover the cost of organizing the championships.
- 7.4 All the participants travel to the competition venue at the expense of sending organizations.
- 7.5 Heads of delegations shall settle all financial issues and meet accreditation requirements on the day of arrival. Payment to be made on site in **US dollars or euro**.
- 7.6 The Organizing Committee shall provide with accommodation and meals: FIAS President, Secretary General, Chairman of FIAS Technical Commission, Chief Referee, Chief Secretary and 24 referees.

8. AWARDING

- 8.1 Prize-winning athletes shall be awarded with medals, diplomas and presents.
- 8.2 Red sambo uniform is required at the awarding ceremony.
- 8.3 During the awarding ceremony national anthem will be played along with flying a flag.
- 8.4 Prize-winning teams shall be awarded with cups and diplomas.
