REGULATIONS of the European Championship in sports and combat SAMBO among adults, Minsk (Belarus), 18-22 May 2017

1. General terms.

- 1.1 The European Sambo Championship is to be held in compliance with FIAS Sambo rules and the EFS Regulations.
- 1.2 The European Sambo Championship will be organized and conducted by the European Sambo Federation (EFS) and Republic organization «Byelorussian sambo federation».
- 1.3 The European Sambo Championship is to be held to popularize and develop sambo in Europe and strengthen international sports relations.

2. Date and venue.

- 2.1 The competition will take place from the 18th to the 22 of May 2017 in Minsk, Belarus.
- 2.2 Place of competition: Palace of Sports of Minsk, 4 Pobediteley Avenue, Minsk.
- 2.3 Place of accommodation and accreditation: Hotel Yubileiny, 19 Pobediteley Avenue, Minsk.

3. Conditions of participation.

3.1 National sambo federations affiliated to the European Sambo Federation, having duly paid the ESF membership fee 2017, have a right to take part in the European Sambo Championship among adults.
3.2 Official delegation:

Representative - 1

Coaches - 6

Athletes – 27 (one for each weight category)

Doctors - 3

Masseurs - 2

Referees - 6

Total: 45

- A) The <u>preliminary application forms</u> with the number of participants should be sent to the Championship Organizing Committee no later than the 15^{th} of April 2017 in accordance with annex 1.
- B) The Byelorussian sambo federation will provide visa support only those delegations which will provide lists of participants in a timely manner in accordance with annex 2 no later than the 15th of April 2017.
- C) Applications for accommodation and transfer shall be submitted to the Championship Organizing Committee no later than the 15th of April 2017 in accordance with annex 3.
- D) The final application forms for the athletes' registration according to the weight categories should be submitted to the Championship Organizing Committee no later than the 1st of May 2017 in accordance with annex 4.

4. Technical specifications of the European Sambo Championship: Weight categories:

- sports sambo (men): 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg;
- sports sambo (women): 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, +80 kg;
- combat sambo: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, +100 kg.
- 4.1 Each athlete must undergo a medical examination before leaving the country for the Championship.
- 4.2 The Organizing Committee guarantees first aid to all the participants of sports delegations.
- 4.3 Team places are defined according to the points in the individual classification.
- 4.4 All participants, coaches, referees and representatives must have medical insurance. (According to the Law of the Republic of Belarus «Stay of foreign citizens in the Republic of Belarus» each individual coming to the country must have a medical insurance for the whole period of stay in the Republic of Belarus).

The presence of insurance will be checked at weigh-in. Without health insurance athletes are not allowed to participate in the Championship.

- 4.5 According to the ESF invitation referees with the international category are admitted to referee.
- 4.6 All delegations should bring to the competition their national anthem (CD), and 2 national flags (1 X 2 meters).
- 4.7 The participants of the official ESF competitions have to get a backnumber on their sambo jackets indicating surname and name (max 12 characters), as well as the country code (name of the country). The backnumbers should be ordered on www.sambobacknumber.com

5. Financial terms and rates

5.1 Each member of the official delegation is obliged to contribute 100 € per day (2 meals and accommodation). Transfer from *airport/railway station-hotel-place of the competition venue and back* is 15 € per person. Each national federation should solve all financial issues with the organizing committee before the 18th of April 2017 to the following bank details:

In case of cancellation after April 18, 2017 payments will be lost and not refunded.

5.2 Participants arriving at the competition without being included in the application form the 18th of April, will be admitted after the payment in the amount of 150 € per day.

5.3 The Organizing Committee provides food and lodging to the EFS President, EFS Secretary General, Chief referee, Chief Secretary and 20 referees in accordance with the EFS Regulations. The ESF pays for the referees' work at the competition.

5.4 Registration of the athletes is made by means of the FIAS on-line license and competitions registration system http://registration.sambo-fias.org/. Each National Sambo Federation should get a login and a password from FIAS to log in to its system's account. Admission of the athletes to the competitions is made only by means of the FIAS on-line license and competitions registration system. The cost of license is \$35 USD, all questions related to the registration should be addressed to FIAS: tel.+7(495) 411-61-37, info@sambo-fias.com.

5.5 Each national sambo federation should pay the ESF annual membership fee in line with the ESF regulations.

6. Doping control

The doping tests are carried out by the official regional anti-doping agency recognized by WADA. The selection of athletes for tests will be run according to the FIAS Anti-Doping provisions 2015 based on WADA Anti-Doping Code 2015.

After receipt of notification until arrival at the point of doping control the selected athletes will be always accompanied by the official representative of the organization. The appointed person (his/her corresponding representative in accordance with FIAS Anti-Doping regulations 2016) may accompany the athlete. If the Organizing Committee does not provide participants with accreditation with the photo on it, the selected athlete will be required to provide a valid passport or identity document at the point of doping control. All athletes are required to plan in advance the date and the time of their departure after the end of the competitions taking into consideration that any athlete could be chosen for doping test.

7. Awarding of the winners and prize-winners.

7.1 Sportsmen, won prizes in individual competitions, will be awarded with medals and diplomas. Medals and diplomas are provided by the European Sambo federation.

7.2 Teams which won prizes will be awarded with cups. Cups are provided by the Championship Organizing Committee.

8. Official ceremonies

- 8.1 The competitors should wear red uniform at the official ceremonies of the European Sambo Championship.
- 8.2 The national anthem will be performed and the national flag will be raised in honour of the winners.
- 8.3 The representatives of the national sambo federations will be admitted to the VIP area only in the corresponding clothing, admission in sportswear will be restricted.

9. Accreditation of media

The accreditation of media is only granted according to the ESF approval and should be performed in line with the rules of the registration of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Belarus before April 15, 2017 http://mfa.gov.by/press/accreditation.

In order to ensure the quality of organization and holding of the tournament and necessary conditions for the participants as well, we request you to send the application forms in a timely manner in accordance with the annexes $N_{2}1, 2, 3, 4$.
