

REGULATIONS

of the University SAMBO World Cup 2012

under the patronage of FISU

1. Scope and objectives

- To hold the SAMBO test tournament within the framework of the programme of preparation to the Universiade 2013;
- To develop the basis for inclusion of SAMBO into the programme of FISU University World Championships, with a view to include it in the programme of Universiades;
- To expand the range of international FIAS sporting events in SAMBO for various groups within the context of meeting the requirements of IOC.

2. Terms and Venue

The University SAMBO World Cup 2012 will be held from 30 November till 3 December 2012 (November 30 is the day of arrival while December 3 should be the day of departure) in Kazan (Russia).

The competitions shall be held in the Combat Palace "AK BARS".

3. Competition programme

30 November (Friday) - arrival	
11.00-16.00	Accreditation, trainings
17.00-18.00	Weighing of athletes in the following weight categories: - men: 52, 62, 74, 90, over 100 kg; - women: 48, 56, 64, 72, over 80 kg
1 December (Saturday)	
10.00	The beginning of the competition. Preliminary events in the following weight categories: - men: 52, 62, 74, 90, over 100 kg; - women: 48, 56, 64, 72, over 80 kg
15.00-16.00	Weighing of athletes in the following weight categories: - men: 57, 68, 82, 100 kg; - women: 52, 60, 68, 80 kg.
17.00	Opening ceremony. Final events, awarding of winners and prize winners.

2 December (Sunday)	
10.00	The beginning of the competition. Preliminary events in the following weight categories: - men: 57, 68, 82, 100 kg; - women: 52, 60, 68, 80 kg.
16.00	Final events, awarding of winners and prize winners. Closing ceremony.
3 December (Monday) - departure	

4. Competitors

The following categories shall be admitted to the competition:

- Full-time students of higher educational institutions;
- Graduates with state-recognized diplomas received in 2012;
- The age of competitors shall not exceed 27 years as of January 1 of the current year;
- Weight categories for men: 52, 57, 62, 68, 74, 82, 90, 100, over 100 kg;
- Weight categories for women: 48, 52, 56, 60, 64, 68, 72, 80, over 80 kg.
- The country can be represented only by one athlete in one weight category.

Official delegation (23 persons max.):

- Head – 1 person,
- Coach – 2 people,
- Referee – 1 person,
- Doctor – 1 person,
- Athletes – men - 9 persons, women- 9 persons.

5. Conditions and procedure of holding competition

Individual and team competitions

The competition shall be held according to the rules existing in FIAS. The competition among men and women shall be held as per the Olympic system with repechage from semi-finalists. The first, second and two third prizes shall be up for grabs in each weight category. The first, second and third places shall be determined separately among men's and women's national teams.

6. Awarding

The winners and runners-up of the competitions as per individual classification shall be awarded with medals and diplomas, as per team classification – with cups and diplomas.

The coaches of athletes being the winners in the individual competitions of the programme shall be awarded with diplomas.

7. Safety Provision

The competition shall be held in sporting venues meeting the requirements of relevant regulations existing in the territory of the Russian Federation and aimed at peacekeeping and ensuring safety of the competitors and viewers, provided that the documents on sporting venues readiness for running sporting events, to be approved as appropriate, are available.

8. Competitors insurance

Participation in the competitions shall be carried out only provided that there is an accident (life and health) insurance contract (original) for each competitor, to be submitted to the Organizing Committee of the Competitions.

9. Application Procedure and Period

Preliminary applications for participation in the Competitions (number of delegates, date and time of arrival) shall be sent to All-Russian SAMBO Federation till 15 October 2012. The teams seeking for visa support shall send the list, and enclose the copies of passports including the information on the embassy in which the visa is going to be received.

On the day of arrival the following documents shall be submitted to the Admission Committee:

- Application from the country (in 2 copies);
- Competitors' passports;
- Original accident insurance contracts;
- Student IDs or grade books (confirming the status of a full-time student), or certified copies of diplomas on graduation in 2012;
- FIAS license for 2012 (the license book cost is 10 USD, annual license cost is 25 USD).
