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REGULATIONS

European SAMBO Championships 2021, Youth (M-W) and Juniors (M-W), SPORTS SAMBO M&W, COMBAT SAMBO M, Cyprus, Limassol 24-30 May 2021

1. General terms

- 1.1. European Sambo Championships 2021 carried out in accordance with applicable Rules of Sambo and Regulations of FIAS and ESF.
- 1.2. European Sambo Championships 2021 will be organized and conducted by the European Sambo Federation (ESF) and the Cyprus Sambo Federation in cooperation with the Cyprus Sport Organization (CSO).
- 1.3. European Sambo Championships 2021 is held to popularize and develop sambo in Europe and strengthen the sport of international relations.

2. Date and venue

- 2.1. The championships will take place from 24 to 30 May 2021 in Limassol, Cyprus.

3. Conditions of participation

- 3.1. National Sambo Federations affiliated to the European Federation SAMBO may take part in European Sambo Championships.

- 3.3. National Sambo Federations affiliated to the European Sambo Federation will take part in European Sambo Championships among adults SPORTS SAMBO M&W, COMBAT SAMBO M (athletes not younger than 2003).
- 3.4. Not more than 1 athlete per weight category from the national team is allowed to take part in the competition.
- 3.5 To enter Cyprus and participate in the competitions, each team member must pass COVID-19 PCR test in their respective countries and have a negative result taken no earlier than 72 hours before arrival. The test results must be sent by e-mail to the Organizing Committee of the competitions, and a hard copy presented at the accreditation.
- 3.6.To enter Cyprus 24 hours before arrival every member of delegation must register on the web-site https://cyprusflightpass.gov.cy/en/home. Upon arrival to the Cyprus Republic all the members of delegation must pass COVID-19 PCR test in the airports of Larnaca or Paphos. Price for the test is 32 euro per 1 person.
- 3.7. The preliminary applications.
- 3.7.1. The preliminary applications for the number of participation should be sent to the Championships Organizing Committee no later than 30 April 2021 in accordance with Annex № 1.
- 3.7.2. Cyprus Sambo Federation will provide visa support only those delegations, which will provide lists of participants in a timely manner in accordance with **Annex № 2** no later than **30 April 2021**.
- 3.7.3. Applications for booking accommodation and transfers shall be submitted to the Championships Organizing Committee no later than 30 April 2021, in accordance with Annex N_2 3 and Annex N_2 4. 3.7.4. The final applications for the registration of athletes in weight category should be submitted to the Championships Organizing Committee no later than 30 April 2021, in accordance with Annex N_2 1.

4. Technical specifications of the Championships

- 4.1. Competitions are conducted in accordance with FIAS rules.
- 4.2 Each athlete must undergo a medical examination before leaving the country for the Championships. Results of medical examinations should be marked in the FIAS medical certificate.
- 4.3 Organizing Committee guarantees the first aid provision to all participants of the sports delegations.
- 4.4 Team places are defined according to the points in the individual classification.
- 4.5 All participants, coaches, referees and representatives must have medical insurance.

The insurance will be checked at weigh-in. Without health insurance athletes are not allowed to participate in the championships.

- 4.6 Only referees of the international category invited officially by FIAS are allowed to officiate. Referees work is paid by ESF.
- 4.7 All delegations must be in possession of an audio recording of the national anthem (CD), 2 National flags (1 X 2 meters).

5. Financial terms and rates

- 5.1. Each member of the official delegation should pay 100 €/ day (2 meals, accommodation). Due to the current COVID-19 pandemic there will be a "bubble" system at the event. All members of each team must stay in the official hotels of the competitions during the whole period of their stay in Cyprus. Independent accommodation in non-official hotels is not allowed.
- 5.2. Transfer cost from / to Larnaca or Paphos airports to / from hotel and competition venue is 15 € /person.
- 5.3. The heads of delegations must resolve all financial issues with the organizing committee on the day of arrival and fulfill all the requirements for accreditation.
- 5.4. Participants who arrive at the competition, but were not included in the application sent until 30 April 2021, will have to pay **120** € / day.
- 5.5 The organizing Committee provides food and lodging of ESF President, ESF Secretary General, the Chairman of referee committee, Chief referee, Chief Secretary and the 20 referees in accordance with the rules of ESF.
- 5.6. Registration of the athletes is made by means of the FIAS Electronic System (FIAS Database) at https://fms.sambo.sport/login. Each National Sambo Federation should get a login, a password and the instructions how to use the Database. Admission of the athletes to the competitions will be carried out through the Database. All questions related to the registration in FIAS Database should be addressed to FIAS at info@sambo-fias.com or +7(495)4116137.
- 5.7. The cost of the FIAS license is 60 USD, which also includes international sports insurance for the selected FIAS competitions. These competitions are included in the list of FIAS international competitions selected for the 2021 insurance program (the terms and conditions of Insurance are provided upon the request of the NSF at info@sambo-fias.com; the NSF is responsible for informing of athletes and officials with the Insurance Rules in advance). Each participant paying 60 USD for the FIAS license fee is automatically included into the insurance programme and gets a medical sports insurance. According to the insurance programme rules it is not prohibited to have another insurance but the price for license will remain 60 USD. Any other member of the team (officials), also wishing to be included in the FIAS insurance programme, may do so, by making the according payment in amount of 60 USD.

License payment and insurance of participants of the Competitions should be executed by the National Sambo Federations whose teams take part in the Competitions.

5.8. Each national sambo federation should pay the ESF annual membership fee in the amount of 300 euros (three hundred) in line with the ESF regulations.

6. Doping control

6.1. The doping tests are carried out by the official Anti-Doping organization or sample collection provider recognized and approved by WADA. The selection of athletes would be according to the 2021 FIAS Anti-Doping rules which are based on 2021 WADA Anti-Doping Code.

After receipt of notification until arrival at the point of doping control the selected athletes will be always accompanied by the official representative of the organization. The selected athlete has right to be accompany by one representative who helps him with translation. The official language during the doping control is English. If the Organizing Committee does not provide participants with accreditation with the photo on it, the selected athlete will be required to provide a valid passport or identity document at the point of doping control. All athletes are required to plan in advance the date and the time of their departure from the competitions taking into consideration that any athlete could be chosen for doping test.

7. Awarding of winners

7.1 Sportsmen won prizes will be awarded with medals, diplomas and gifts

8. Official ceremonies

- 8.1 Competitors participate in the official ceremonies of the European Championship in red jackets.
- 8.2 To honor the winners the national anthem will be performed and the national flag will be raised.
- 8.3 Representatives of the National Federations will be admitted to the VIP area in the corresponding clothing only, the admission in sportswear will be prohibited.
