1. GENERAL TERMS.

- Popularisation of the sport of sambo in the world.
- Improving the skills of athletes.
- Strengthening international sporting relations.

2. DATES AND VENUE.

2.1. International competitions "Sambo Founders Cup" in sport sambo among men and women and combat sambo among men (hereinafter - the Competition) are held in Moscow from March 23 to March 26, 2026, including the day of arrival on March 23, 2026, and the day of departure on March 26, 2026.

2.2 Venue of the competition - International Sambo Centre, Moscow, Novoluzhnetsky Proezd 13, Moscow.

2.3 Accreditation venue - Aerostar Hotel, Moscow, Leningradsky Prospekt 37, building 9.

2.4 Place of accommodation for participants and delegations - Aerostar Hotel, Moscow, Leningradsky Prospekt 37, building 9.

3. COMPETITION ORGANIZERS.

3.1. The general management of the organisation and holding of the Competition shall be carried out by the Ministry of Sport of the Russian Federation (hereinafter referred to as the Ministry of Sport of Russia), the All-Russian Sambo Federation, the Department of Sport of the City of Moscow (hereinafter referred to as Moskomsport) and the Regional Public Organisation 'Sambo Federation of Moscow' (hereinafter referred to as the Sambo Federation of Moscow).

3.2. The All-Russian Sambo Federation and the Panel of Referees approved by the All-Russian Sambo Federation shall be responsible for organising the Competition directly.

4. TERMS OF PARTICIPATION.

4.1. The competitions shall be held in accordance with the Sambo Rules, the Rules of Combat Sambo of the International Sambo Federation (hereinafter referred to as the Rules) and the Regulations of the International Sambo Federation for Organising and Conducting Official Competitions (hereinafter referred to as the Regulations).

4.2. Athletes of sports teams of the member countries of the International Sambo Federation, not younger than 2008 year of birth shall participate in the Competitions.

4.3. Weight categories:

Men – 58, 64, 71, 79, 88, 98, over 98 kg;

Women – 50, 54, 59, 65, 72, 80, over 80 kg;

Combat sambo (men) - 58, 64, 71, 79, 88, 98, over 98 kg.

4.4. When passing the admission commission, each National Sambo Federation is obliged to present the following documents:

- **application for the participation of athletes, drawn up on the letterhead of the National Sambo Federation with the signature and stamp of the managing person;**
 - **copy of life insurance policy for each athlete against accidents (abroad).**
- Insurance of the participants is carried out at the expense of the sending organisations.**

Participation in the Competitions is carried out only if there are supporting documents on life and health insurance against accidents for each participant.

4.5. All delegations must provide the Organising Committee with a short version (no more than 30 seconds) of the respective national anthem in electronic format and two 2x1m national flags.

4.6. Admission to refereeing at competitions for foreign referees is agreed with the chairman of the refereeing commission of the All-Russian Sambo Federation.

4.7. In accordance with the Regulations on Organising and Conducting Official Competitions of the International Sambo Federation, each participant is obliged to have a number on the back of his uniform (red and blue) consisting of his surname and the abbreviation of the name of his country.

4.8. The order of bouts and determination of the winners of the Competition shall be carried out in accordance with the Rules

4.9. Individual and team competitions.

5. APPLICATIONS.

5.1. Registration of athletes for the Competition is carried out by submitting an application (Appendix No.1), which must be sent to the Organising Committee of the Competition until 1 March 2026.

5.2. The Organising Committee of the Competition will provide accommodation with breakfast (only in the specified official hotels) and transfers for the National Sambo Federations that have applied for accommodation and transfers not later than 1 March 2026.

5.3. In case the application for accommodation with breakfast (only in the specified official hotels) and transfer from the National Sambo Federation is submitted later than March 1, 2026, the Organising Committee of the Competition reserves the right to refuse to provide accommodation and transfer.

5.4. Requests for booking accommodation and transfers shall be submitted to the Competition Organising Committee in accordance with Appendix No. 2 and Appendix No. 3.

5.5. All participants who require a visa to enter the Russian Federation must apply for a visa at the Consular Department of the Embassy of the Russian Federation in their country. The visa fee for visa application to the Russian Federation, which can be arranged for each participant, must be paid independently by the respective National Sambo Federation or by the individual participant. The cost of the visa fee may vary depending on the country.

The All-Russian Sambo Federation will provide the necessary visa support, subject to prior notice, until 20 February 2026.

5.6. Applications for visa support shall be submitted to the Competition Organising Committee in accordance with Appendix No. 4 and copies of passports in electronic form.

6. FINANCIAL TERMS.

6.1. The costs of sending participants to the Competition shall be borne by the sending organisation.

6.2. The Organising Committee of the Competition provides transfers from international airports (Sheremetyevo, Vnukovo, Domodedovo) and/or railway stations of Moscow to the official hotel and back, as well as transfers from the official hotel to the competition venue and back.

6.3. The Organizing Committee of the Competition provides a free quota for accommodation and meals (breakfast only) for 10 (ten) representatives of National Sambo Federations for the entire period of the Competition (23 – 26.03.2025).

6.3. In case of exceeding the quota for free accommodation allocated for each National Sambo Federation, the Organizing Committee of the Competition provides accommodation in a hotel with breakfast (only in the specified official hotels) at the price of 6000,00 rubles of the Russian Federation per participant per day (single accommodation with breakfast), 4000,00 rubles of the Russian Federation per participant per day (double accommodation with breakfast) for the competition period from March 23 to March 26, 2026.

7. INTERNATIONAL TRAINING CAMP.

7.1. The international training camp will be held in Moscow from March 26 to 28, 2026, with training days on March 26 and 27, 2026.

7.2. Venue of the international training event - International Sambo Center, 13 Novoluzhnetsky Proezd, Moscow.

7.3. Place of accommodation for participants - Salyut Hotel, Moscow, Leninsky Prospekt 158.

7.4. The costs of sending participants to an international training camp are borne by the sending organization.

7.5. Participation in the international training camp is carried out at the expense of the sending organization and is paid in the amount of 9500 Russian rubles per person per day accommodation (single occupancy, meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner), 7000 Russian rubles per person per day accommodation (double occupancy, meals: breakfast, lunch, dinner), transfer (from the venue to the hotel and back), sports facilities services.

7.6. Registration for the international training camp is carried out by submitting an application, which must be sent to the Organizing Committee no later than March 8, 2026.

8. AWARDING.

8.1. Participants who took first, second and two third places in each weight category are awarded with medals and diplomas.

8.2. The three best teams at the end of the competition are awarded with cups.

8.3. The red sambo uniform is compulsory at official ceremonies.
